"He is before all things, and in Him all things consist." —Col 1:17

of all energy. He described Himself to Moses as "I AM." That means He's everything—everything you and I will ever need at any time!

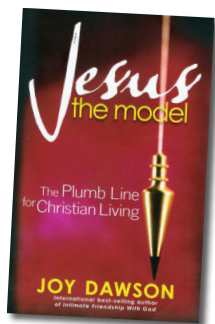

FEDERAL GOVERNMENT

Repent for Congress' deceptive passage and President Obama's signing of pro-homosexual hate crime laws. (See Page 4) Use IFA's "Top 130 U.S. Officials" bookmark (a "Prayer Guide" available on "Resources" at www.ifapray.org) to intercede for President Obama, Vice President Biden, the Cabinet, staff, and families. Affirm the supremacy of Christ over the Obama administration, the 111th Congress, the Supreme Court, and all U.S. agencies. Pray for your U.S. Senators and Representative and all top officials. Intercede that the sanctity of human life, biblical morality and ethics, constitutional principles, and sound fiscal policy be upheld in legislation regarding religious freedom, health care, abortion, marriage and family, taxation, immigration, energy, the federal deficit, and national debt.

FOREIGN POLICY / ISRAEL

Intercede for the White House "War Council" which reviews policy and advises on warfare against al Qaida / Taliban forces, and defusing nuclear threats from Iran and North Korea. Intercede that "wisdom from above," strategy, and resolve be granted to President Barack Obama, Vice President Joe Biden, Secretary of Defense Robert Gates, Secretary of State Hillary Clinton, National Security Advisor Gen. James Jones, Chairman of the Joint Chiefs of Staff Adm. Mike Mullen, CENTCOM Commander Gen. David Petraeus, and Commander of NATO forces in Afghanistan Gen. Stanley McChrystal. Intercede that the Lord cause this Council, along with Middle East Envoy George Mitchell and UN Ambassador Susan Rice, to heed His Word and posture regarding Israel, Jerusalem, and the Middle East.

“I will inspire them to fear Me...”

The Christmas season is a great time to pray through the character and purpose of God as related to nations. The prophetic words of Jeremiah, though written thousands of years ago, are still applicable to the U.S. in the 21st century.

Concerning national restoration, in Jeremiah 32:27 we find these words: “Is anything too hard for me . . . I am about to. . .” The Lord reminds us in these ten words that He is a God who is in ultimate control and that He is a God of redemptive action.

Hundreds of years ago, there was a group of people who were convinced that God had more liberty and destiny for them than they were experiencing. God put upon their hearts to leave their country and go to a new land so they would have the freedom to follow God in accord with scripture. They made arrangements to board a ship. They left their families, members of their congregation, their possessions, and their security because they were convinced that God had something greater for them. Only a few days out to sea the ship had to return to port because of structural failure.

With their money spent and their plan thwarted, they sought God, who promises that “nothing is too difficult.” They discovered a ship that had room and needed passengers, free of charge! So, they boarded the Mayflower, endured a difficult voyage, and became a very important part of our U.S. history!

Not only is God able to work in challenging circumstances, but He is also able to change the hearts of citizens within a nation. “I will give them singleness of heart and action . . . I will inspire them to fear Me.” (Jer 32:39-40 NIV) America was once a nation that could have been described by this very scripture. Daniel Webster was once asked, “What is the most sobering thought that ever entered your mind?” He quickly responded, “My personal accountability to God.” Those simple words describe how a nation can apply the words of Jeremiah.

It is amazing that this perspective was assumed by our founding fathers, but the real question is – how did it become assumed? There had to be circumstances that would have brought a large number of people to this point of view. There had to be writings and conversations that reinforced it. It had to be God who inspired and “gave them singleness of heart and action” to fear Him.

Finally, we find God’s ultimate purposes for a nation, that they “bring Me renown, joy, praise, and honor before all nations on earth.” (Jer 33:9) It would be interesting to ask politicians of our day to write a one sentence purpose for our nation. It would be interesting to compare those statements with the 1636 “Rules and Precepts” of Harvard University which stated, “Let every student be plainly instructed and earnestly pressed to consider well, the main end of his life and studies is, to know God and Jesus Christ which is eternal life.” A nation full of individuals who have been educated in this type of environment would certainly produce a nation that would bring renown, joy, praise, and honor to God.

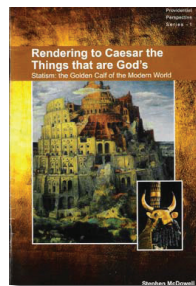

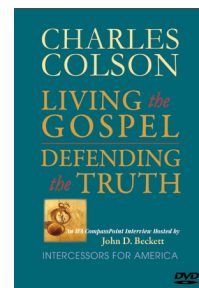

The Enduring Revolution vs. Modernity

In March 1993 Charles W. Colson, founder of Prison Fellowship, was named recipient of the Templeton Prize for Progress in Religion. On September 2, 1993, as part of the Templeton Award ceremonies at the University of Chicago, he delivered an address on religious liberty. It was largely overlooked by the secular media and unfortunately by many in the Church. Because Charles Colson faced an audience comprised of members of the Parliament of the World's Religions, this historic address is a profound and lasting example of what evangelicals might lovingly proclaim in a pluralistic setting.

We witnessed a pivotal moment in history. . . . The balance of world power shifted dramatically. Suddenly, remarkably, almost inexplicably, one of history's most sustained assaults on freedom collapsed before our eyes.

This revolution's symbolic moment was May Day 1990. Protesters followed the tanks, missiles, and troops rumbling across Red Square. One, a bearded Orthodox monk, darted under the reviewing stand where Gorbachev and other Soviet leaders stood. He thrust a huge crucifix into the air, shouting above the crowd, "Mikhail Sergeyevich! Christ is risen!" Gorbachev turned and walked off the platform.

Across a continent the signal went. In defiant hope a spell was broken. The lies of decades were exposed. Fear and terror fled. And millions awoke as from a long nightmare. The world was changed, not through the militant dialectic of communism, but through the power of unarmed truth. This was one of history's defining moments.

The faults of the West are evident—but equally evident are the extraordinary gifts it has to offer the world. The gift of markets that increase living standards and choices. The gift of political institutions where power flows from the consent of the governed, not the barrel of a gun. The gift of social beliefs that encourage tolerance and individual autonomy.

Free markets. Free governments. Free minds.

But just at this moment, after the struggle of the last century. . . the culture that fashioned this freedom is being overrun. It has embraced the destructive myths of modernity, which are poisoning its wellspring of justice and virtue and stripping away its most essential humanizing, civilizing influence.

Make no mistake: This humanizing, civilizing influence is the Judeo-Christian heritage. It is a heritage brought to life anew in each generation by men and women whose lives are transformed by the living God and filled with holy conviction.

Despite the failures of some of its followers—the crusades and inquisitions—this heritage

has laid the foundations of freedom in the West. It has established a standard of justice over both men and nations. It has proclaimed a higher law that exposes the pretensions of tyrants. It has taught that every human soul is on a path of immortality, that every man and woman is to be treated as the child of a King.

This muscular faith has motivated excellence in art and discovery in science. It has undergirded an ethic of work and an ethic of service. It has tempered freedom with internal restraint, so our laws could be permissive while our society was not.

Christian conviction inspires public virtue, the moral impulse to do good. It has sent legions into battle against disease, oppression, and bigotry. It ended the slave trade, built hospitals and orphanages, tamed the brutality of mental wards and prisons. In every age it has given divine mercy a human face in the lives of those who follow Christ.

Christian conviction also shapes personal virtue, the moral imperative to be good. It subdues an obstinate will. It ties a tether to self-interest and violence.

Finally, Christian conviction provides a principled belief in human freedom. As Lord Acton [1834-1902] explained, "Liberty is the highest political end of man . . . [But] no country can be free without religion. It creates and strengthens the notion of duty. If men are not kept straight by duty, they must be by fear. The more they are kept by fear, the less they are free. The greater the strength of duty, the greater the liberty."

The kind of duty to which Acton refers is driven by the most compelling motivation. I and every other Christian have experienced it. It is the duty that flows from gratitude to God that He would send His only Son to die so we might live.

This is the lesson of centuries: that ordered liberty is one of faith's triumphs. And yet, western cultural and political elites seem blinded by modernity's myths to the historic civilizing role of Christian faith. And so, in the guise of pluralism and tolerance, they have set about to exile religion from our common life. They use the power of the media and the law like steel wool to scrub public debates and public places bare of religious ideas and symbols. But what is left is sterile and featureless and cold.

These elites seek freedom without self-restraint, liberty without standards. But they find instead the revenge of offended absolutes. Courts strike down even perfunctory prayers, and we are surprised that schools, bristling with barbed wire, look more like prisons than prisons do. Universities reject the very idea of truth, and we are shocked when the best and the

brightest of their graduates loot and betray.

Celebrities mock the traditional family, even revile it as a form of slavery, and we are appalled at the human tragedy of broken homes and millions of unwed mothers. The media celebrate sex without responsibility, and we are horrified by sexual plagues. Our lawmakers justify the taking of innocent life in sterile clinics, and we are terrorized by the disregard for life in blood-soaked streets.

C. S. Lewis described this irony a generation ago. "We laugh at honor," he said, "and are shocked to find traitors in our midst. . . . We castrate and bid the geldings be fruitful." A generation of cultural leaders wants to live off the spiritual capital of its inheritance, while denigrating the ideals of its ancestors. It squanders a treasure it no longer values. It celebrates its liberation when it should be trembling for its future.

Where does this stampede lead us? Only one place: tyranny. A new kind of cultural tyranny that finds minds, uninformed by traditions and standards, easy to shape.

Philosopher Hannah Arendt described totalitarianism as a process where lonely, rootless individuals, deprived of meaning and community, welcome the captivity of ideology. To escape their inner emptiness, they seek out new forms of servitude. Trading independence for security, they blend into faceless conformity. The lonely crowd always finds a leader. It submits to the party line and calls it freedom. America is filled with willing recruits to follow a new Grand Inquisitor.

This coming cultural tyranny already casts its shadow across university campuses where repressive speech codes stifle free debate; across court houses and legislatures where officials hunt down and purge every religious symbol; across network newsrooms and board rooms where nothing is censored except traditional belief. Our modern elites speak of enlightened tolerance while preparing shackles for those who disagree.

Disdaining the past and its values, we flee the judgment of the dead. We tear down memory's monuments—removing every guidepost and landmark—and wander in unfamiliar country. But it is a sterile wasteland in which men and women are left with carefully furnished lives and utterly barren souls.

This is irony without humor—farce without joy. Western elites are carefully separating the wheat from the chaff and keeping the chaff. They are performing a modern miracle of turning wine into water.

This crisis is not only alarming, it is also urgent.

2000 BABIES SAVED FROM ABORTION

★ COLLEGE STATION, TX – The fall September 23 – November 1 40 Days for Life campaign organizers reported that 542 babies were saved during this vigil. Begun in 2004, the 40 Days for Life community campaigns incorporating prayer and fasting and public witness reached a milestone of knowing that at least 2,000 babies have been spared from abortion. “Two thousand children would be enough to fill at least 80 classrooms or make up 180 teams of little soccer players,” said Executive Director David Bereit. CIRCUIT COURT REJECTS BUFFER LAW

★ PHILADELPHIA, PA – The U.S. Court of Appeals for the 3rd Circuit struck down an ordinance as unconstitutional for prohibiting speech in specified “buffer” zones outside Pittsburgh abortion clinics. Alliance Defense Fund (ADF) attorneys represented a pro-life nurse in Brown vs. City of Pittsburgh who challenged the ordinance, which prohibited her from speaking with women near the clinics. ADF said this is a precedent-setting ruling upholding pro-life free speech at abortion clinics. (AP ADF 11/2/09)

U.S. CHILD SEX SLAVES RESCUED

★ VANCOUVER, WA – Shared Hope Int'l Founder, Linda Smith (U.S. Congress 1994-98), reported that 52 victims of child sex slavery were rescued during an October initiative. Nearly 900 victims have now been rescued. Visit www.sharedhope.org. (CN 10/31/09)

RELIGIOUS ORNAMENTS BANNED ON 2009 CAPITOL CHRISTMAS TREE

PHOENIX, AZ – Attorneys with the Alliance Defense Fund petitioned Arizona state and federal officials to stop enforcing a requirement prohibiting the state's schoolchildren from expressing religious themes while crafting ornaments for the 2009 Capitol Christmas Tree in Washington, DC. Arizona was chosen this year to present 4,000 handcrafted ornaments made by elementary through high-school students. Ornament guidelines directed that “Ornaments cannot reflect a religious or political theme....” (LSN 9/30/09)

NATIONWIDE CHRISTMAS WITNESS

★ TUPELO, MS – The above Merry Christmas buttons and stickers were distributed nationwide by the American Family Association (AFA) as a tool for a simple and beautiful community Christmas witness. Founded in 1977 by Donald E. Wildmon, who was pastoring First United Methodist Church in Southaven, Mississippi, the ministry is now headed by his son, Tim Wildmon.

AFA has been on the frontlines of America's culture war for over 30 years. AFA helped spearhead the TEA Party rallies across the nation. It owns and operates nearly 200 radio stations across the country under the American Family Radio (AFR) banner. Other divisions of AFA include OneNewsNow.com, a global online news provider, and activist Christian web sites such as OneMillionMoms.com and OneMillionDads.com. AFA, like IFA, believes that a culture based on Biblical truth best serves the well-being of our country as evidenced by the vision of our forefathers as set forth in the Declaration of Independence.

REP. BART STUPAK REFUTES BARACK OBAMA'S "HYDE AMENDMENT MYTH"

★ WASHINGTON, DC – In his speech before a joint session of Congress and the nation on September 9, 2009, Barack Obama stated: “And one more misunderstanding I want to clear up—under our plan, no federal dollars will be used to fund abortions, and federal conscience laws will remain in place.” As Health Care Reform plans emerged for scrutiny, nine-term Representative Bart Stupak (D-MI) telephoned the President and confronted him about the apparent duplicity, as both the Senate and House plans called for the public funding of elective abortion.

Rep. Stupak said that in the conversation President Obama stated that when he claimed in the speech that their plan would not fund abortions, he was not talking about the House or Senate plan, he was talking about his own plan which was never written. White House aides continued to quote the President's 9/9/09 promise of no funding because “federal conscience laws will remain in place.” Health reform advocates in Congress publicly stated that “there is already a law that prohibits federal funding of abortion—the Hyde Amendment—and that they do not intend to ‘repeal’ this law.”

This “doublespeak” by the Obama White House and abortion funding advocates in Congress has now been dubbed “The Hyde Amendment Myth” and has been termed a “political hoax” by National Right to Life Legislative Director, Douglas Johnson. In reality, the Hyde Amendment would not apply in any way to the new programs that health care legislation would create. The Hyde Amendment took effect in 1977 and was passed to specifically stop the funding of elective abortions through the HHS appropriations Medicaid program, which had been paying for 300,000 abortions annually.

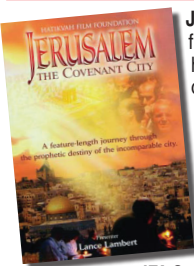
Any “public option” type health care legislation would establish a new nationwide health insurance program run entirely by the federal government. It would authorize that program to pay for elective abortions out of funds in the U.S. Treasury, not through annual HHS appropriations. Thus, this new funding of elective abortion would not be covered and curtailed by the Hyde Amendment. (NRL 9/3/09 CNS 10/26/09 C-Span LAT 10/27/09)

CYBER SECURITY CENTER DEDICATED

★ WASHINGTON, DC – Homeland Security Secretary Janet Napolitano, Reps. Dutch Ruppersberger (D-MD) and Dan Lundgren (R-CA), and other officials opened the National Cybersecurity and Communications Integration Center (NCCIC) in Arlington, VA in late October. This new center is designed to help provide and unify a 24-hour, 365-day watch over the U.S. cyber infrastructure. “We are being attacked everyday,” said Rep. Lundgren. (TRN 10/30/09)

FBI data shows that the number of names on the U.S. terror watch now numbers some 400,000. (WP 11/1/09)
