Could Roe v. Wade be overturned soon?

An [opportunity](#) for another Supreme Court appointment by President Trump increases the likelihood that Roe v. Wade, long viewed as “[bad law](#),” could be overturned even this year. That prospect has pro-life Americans hopeful and pro-abortion activists panicked. But even without any change in the Supreme Court, cases that challenge Roe v. Wade are coming. **Pro-abortion activists are deeply concerned about [June Medical Services vs. Gee](#), currently before the Supreme Court.** The liberal media outlet [Think Progress](#) reports that “Yes, the court is very unlikely to hand down an opinion this week which uses the words ‘Roe v. Wade is overruled.’ But ...[w]hen the court refuses to enforce its own decision, that will send a clear signal to lower court judges throughout the country that they are free to uphold restrictions on abortion.” The Court is expected to have a decision on the emergency filing on February 7th.

How will this case unravel Roe v. Wade?

Louisiana's [June Medical Services v. Gee](#) is similar to the Texas case [Whole Women's Health Alliance vs. Hellerstedt](#), which was struck down by the Supreme Court in 2016. “The Whole Woman's Health decision was the court's most important one on abortion in a quarter-century. But it was decided by a very different Supreme Court, in the wake of

the death of conservative Justice Antonin Scalia. . . . Chief Justice John G. Roberts Jr., Justice Samuel A. Alito Jr. and Thomas were in dissent. But those three have since been joined by President Trump's choices, Justice Neil M. Gorsuch and Brett M. Kavanaugh, both of whom were supported by [pro-life] activists who said they hoped that the new court majority might one day overturn the fundamental right to abortion the court advanced in Roe v. Wade,” reports the liberal [Washington Post](#).

According to progressive journalist Ian Millhiser, “**Should the Supreme Court deny a stay in the Gee case, moreover, anti-abortion judges will know exactly what that means. It will be a clear signal that they can emulate the Fifth Circuit and openly defy Supreme Court decisions protecting a right to abortion.**” (*Keep in mind that Millhiser sees this scenario as bad news—but in reality it is very good news for life.*)

What should we do?

Immediate prayer and fasting is needed! Please pray for the Court to recognize the Fifth Circuit Court's decision. The focus has already shifted to the states, with the introduction of multiple states removing all restrictions for abortion. But we believe God is at work!

Why the flurry of activity NOW to pass state laws guaranteeing unlimited abortions?

1. The focus for abortion activists has been largely federal—protecting the current national “right to abortion.” With growing potential for a Roe v. Wade overturn, **states are the new battleground** where abortion can be regulated, permitted, or outlawed.

2. The pro-life movement has made some great inroads in protecting life through state heartbeat bills and other kinds of legislation. The pro-abortion lobby is countering those strides and trying to preempt any further legislation by passing sweeping abortion laws with few limits. **Pray for state lawmakers!**

8 states plus D.C. currently allow unrestricted abortion up to birth:

Pray for these 8 states (plus Washington, D.C.), who currently have the most liberal abortion laws in the nation, with no real restrictions on [late-term abortions](#). Lift up the governors who currently lead these states. (Some laws were passed before these governors took office.) **Pray also for the state lawmakers who are in the position of authority to either invite righteousness or bring judgment upon their state. Pray that no more states join this**
