As you look at the picture of the virus (above), you see the barbs sticking out of the nucleus. These barbs are like tentacles that attach themselves to the host, creating an opening and affect the host from within. From a spiritual standpoint, that is much like a stronghold, where a spirit will wedge in and take root, negatively affecting the host. Let's pray with this spiritual strategy to "dismantle" the spirits behind coronavirus and all that is "attached" to it—piece by piece, using God's Word.
